CAS to keep same priorities of the CoC, which will be added to the MOU between Lake County &amp; MFHC.</p> <p>Tomi Steinruck provided an update on the CoC.</p> <p>~CDC Moratorium has been extended to July 31, 2021. MFHC has seen an increase in call volume. The numbers of people temporarily living in motels is high, and there is pushback by families as they are not eligible due to the definition of homelessness.</p> <p>~Hernando - Unsheltered population has reported a mosquito problem. County Health Department was asked for bug spray, but it won't be available until July. Hernando Emergency Management has provided bug spray in the meantime. They offered to go out and spray encampment areas. Hernando Fairgrounds would like to hire some people from the Vineyard for day labor.</p> <p>~Citrus – We are continuing to work with the Health Department to have a vaccine event. The Opioid Taskforce is planning an event soon, and requested someone who works with Veterans to be on those calls.</p> <p>~Sumter – Attendance at the monthly community meetings is growing.</p> <p>~Lake – Outreach has discovered a hot spot with a large increase in homeless. They have been spending a lot of time in Lake County, trying to find everyone, and why they have become homeless.</p> <p>~Tomi will be attending a pallet demonstration for tiny shelters/sheds that can be used for emergency housing. This type of housing can be up to 20 degrees warmer in the winter than the outside temperatures.</p> <p>~Paula Warner from Sunshine Health indicated that Medicaid plans can include bug spray, as well as other over the counter (OTC) medications.</p>
